SHUFFLE BOARD

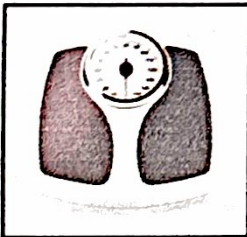


Due to destruction of shuffle board, shuffling is open for anyone to play. Key to equipment is located at end of fireplace in clubhouse.
